I want to offer my sincere appreciation for your tireless participation, your faithful support and the many ways you have contributed to the success of Breakthrough SJC and our students. You have inspired me to strive to give better than my best because our students deserve excellence. Please continue to support our students through Breakthrough SJC. I often think about the world that they will lead and I eagerly await their amazing accomplishments and contributions to our society.

Breakthrough SJC is on its way to even greater achievements under the new leadership of Jesus Montoya, a dedicated educator in our San Juan Capistrano community and longtime supporter of Breakthrough. He comes to Breakthrough having worked with the program over the last five years through his work in the Capistrano Unified School District and as an advocate of education for all students. We are very fortunate to have him join the program.

Breakthrough connects to my life's passion of providing access to education to under-represented communities in higher education and I anticipate continuing this work in the future. Breakthrough SJC will always hold a special place in my heart and I am forever changed by your involvement and partnership.
